






Use this chart to determine when to plant seeds inside, based on the date you can safely put transplants in the ground (typically just after the average date of last frost).

Average Date of Last Frost: _____

(hint: find this on the Farmer's Almanac website!)

Vegetables/Fruits	When to Plant	Your Date
Eggplant, Celery, Onions, Scallions, Leeks 	10 weeks before last frost	
Tomatoes, Peppers Tomatillos 	8 weeks before last frost	
Herbs 	6 weeks before last frost	
Cucumbers, Cauliflower, Brussels Sprouts, Broccoli, Melons 	5 weeks before last frost	
Winter Squash, Zucchini, Summer Squash, Pumpkins 	4 weeks before last frost
